Health Certificates

Health Certificates (HC) are documents required for pet travel. They must be issued within 10 days of travel by a USDA-accredited veterinarian.

Can SHS Do HCs?

Only on a designated health certificate day with a USDA-accredited veterinarian on-island.

When is the next HC Clinic?

These will be announced on social media and website.

FAVN

FAVNs are blood tests that confirm your pet has adequate rabies protection.

Does My Pet Need a FAVN?



FAVN is required for:

- Guam
- Japan
- Hawaii
- South Korea



FAVN is NOT required for:

- U.S. Mainland
- the Philippines

Can SHS do FAVNs?

It depends! These tests require a lot of extra coordinating & logistics. We will announce FAVN clinics on our social media & website.

If FAVN is Required

Rabies vaccine #1 ➡ wait 30+ days ➡ Rabies vaccine #2 ➡ wait 30+ days

*Note: A veterinarian must be present to give rabies vaccine.

**Blood Draw
(FAVN test)**

Results in 6-8 weeks



Don't Wait Until the Last Minute



Within 10 days of travel

Health Certificate



3-4+ months before travel

FAVN destinations



6-8 weeks

Typical FAVN processing time

All rabies vaccines, FAVNs, and HCs must be coordinated with a visiting veterinarian.
